OUTPOURING OF SUPPORT FOR LOCAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHER FIGHTING KIDNEY DISEASE Altoona Community Helping Zach Noel Receive the Gift of Life

ALTOONA, Pa.--Husband, father, brother, son, friend, teacher...and kidney disease warrior. The Altoona community is rallying to provide help and hope to 30-year-old elementary school teacher Zach Noel as he fights back against kidney disease and prepares to receive a life-changing kidney transplant.

Zach has been living with diabetes since he was twelve. Today, the disease has deteriorated his kidney function to the point of kidney failure: Zach must receive a kidney transplant to live a healthy life. Husband of Kim and father of 1-year-old Cora, Zach has been living in the Altoona area all his life. He is a beloved elementary school teacher in the Altoona School District at Juniata Gap Elementary.

Since they learned that he would need a transplant to combat kidney disease, the community has rallied to support Zach. "I am so humbled and thankful by the support we're getting so far," said Zach. "This community is giving our family hope as we take on this journey together."
